# Missionary's Heart

*Psalm 147:<sup>16</sup> He gives snow like wool; He scatters the frost like ashes.*

*<sup>17</sup> He casts forth His ice as fragments; Who can stand before His cold?*

## ***And the snow fell and great was the fall thereof!***

I have noticed that, as the years progress, I become increasingly less excited at the prospect of 'wintery weather'. My wife and children attribute that to advancing age, increasing girth, or any number of other unfounded (and obviously incorrect) assumptions.

The truth is, I have simply become more wise. That is not to say that I am wise, but that over many years of experiencing all that winter has to offer, I have learned some things.



- OR, are going to host a block party using resources from a church or association


• **Each regional training workshop includes:**
