The Children (grades 1-4), Middle-Schoolers (grades 5-7) and Youth (grades 8-12) each have separate Worship and Bible study facilities. The ARVBA has endured her share of transmogrification as well. Our churches use theses rolling carnivals for VBS, Fall Festivals, Easter events, etc. Each year the trailers roll out for the annual Arkansas Baptist State Convention One Day Mission event as well as travel to the Annual Mission Trip location.

And, of course, Church Camp has seen more than a few tweaks in the past ten years. The ARVBA has always been one of the best Camps in the state and adding the Middle-School division just made things even better. Three camps in one location in the same week. Only the ARVBA could do something like that!

As you can imagine, being tethered to the home front has afforded time to focus on upcoming Association events. And, you can also imagine, Church Camp is foremost in my thoughts. I spent some time running down 'the numbers' and was amazed all over again at how the Lord has used the ARVBA Church Camp to aggressively grow His Kingdome. For instances, 'the numbers' revealed that, over the past ten years, your Camp recorded 485 professions of faith!

That number leads me to wonder if we are as excited about our upcoming Camp as we ought to be. It seems to become more difficult each year to convince our churches to bring the unchurched to Lonsdale. You have heard me say for ten years now, "You cannot teach a kid to live for Jesus in a week, but you can help introduce that kid to Jesus, and send

him back to his church whose job it is to Bro Danny teach him to live for Jesus".
