Missionary's Heart

As I wrote in last month's newsletter, this time of year places Church Camp at the forefront of my thought processes. While recuperating at home I spent some time running down our 'Church Camp numbers' and was re-amazed at how the Lord has used that ARVBA ministry to aggressively grow His Kingdom. Those numbers revealed that, over the past ten years, your Camp recorded 485 professions of faith!

That great witness leads me to question why churches across our nation (and even in our Association!) seem to be less excited each year about the most effective tool for evangelism in our ever-diminishing arsenal. We do a great job of getting our own kids to Camp but it is increasingly difficult to convince our churches to bring the unchurched to Lonsdale. How often have you heard me say "You cannot teach a kid to live for Jesus in a week, but you can help introduce that kid to Jesus, and send him or her back to their church whose job it is to teach them to live for Jesus"?

We have an opportunity to do something big for the Lord this year. We can *intentionally* make Camp 2025 more evangelistically impactful by *intentionally* bringing more unchurched kids and teens to Lonsdale. We can *intentionally* encourage our churched kids to *intentionally* invite their unchurched friends to camp (and pay for it if necessary!) The key word, of course is "*Intentionally*".

Mrs. Michelle, Mrs. Talina, and Bros Zach and Paul have worked hard to make this the best Camp ever. Bro. Richard Snyder, Bro. Donald Walker, and Bro Logan Ferguson each has a heart full of messages for the campers. The Association Office is ready. Spring Lake Baptist Camp & Retreat Center is ready. The Holy Spirit is ready. Is your church ready for Camp 2025?!
